The order will be endorsed by the Commonwealth and entered by the Court on the date noticed *without an appearance by counsel* provided the form is used and all other rules applicable to discovery have been met. This order only applies to juvenile and adult misdemeanor prosecutions.

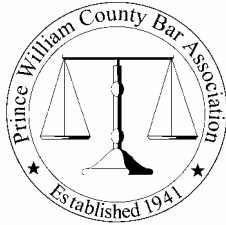

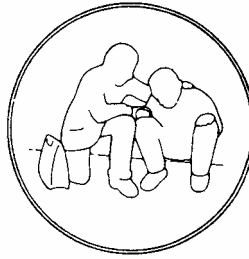
