The Court has received several inquiries about changing the procedure for motions to reconsider sentences imposed. The Court is of the view that the existing procedure should remain in place for the time being. Counsel should continue to file requests for reconsideration with a copy to Chambers. A judge will review the motion and decide whether to grant a hearing on the motion. Please know that judges are on-site each day, Monday through Friday. Every effort will be made to act on such motions within two business days of receipt. It would be helpful if counsel would set forth the specific reasons for the request addressing any facts that might be unique to a given defendant.
